Historic Structure Assessments:

Historic Structure Assessments are reports written on behalf of owners or community custodians of historic buildings, usually those which need repair or upkeep. The format for these reports was originally established by the National Park Service, a branch of the United States Department of the Interiors. Reports include a cultural and construction history, a methodical description of all aspects of the building construction inside and out, from foundation to roof, and descriptions and recommendations for each feature. The final portion of the reports includes a list prioritizing the most important repairs and upkeep necessary to preserve, restore, or rehabilitate the building. Reports generally span 100 to 200 pages in length.
