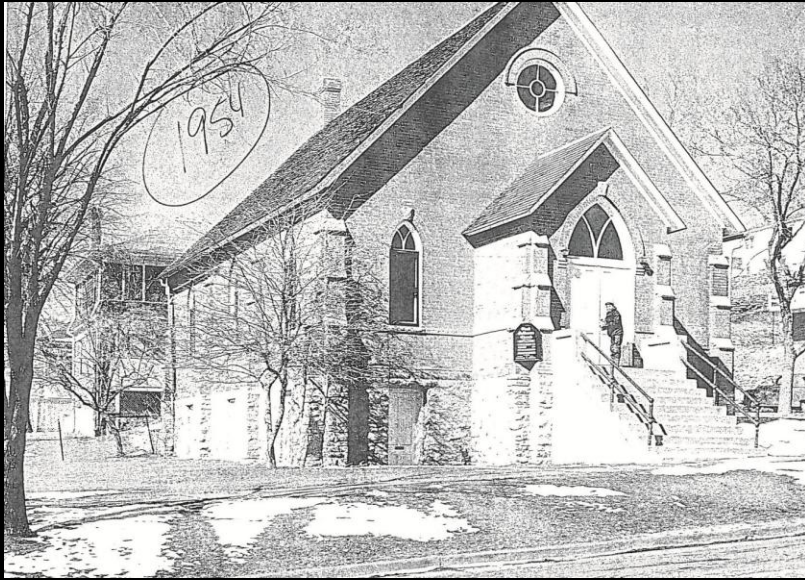

**SWEDISH LUTHERAN CHURCH**  
1894-1895

THIS BUILDING REFLECTS THE SPIRIT IN SWEDISH IMMIGRATION TO COLORADO. THE FIRST SWEDISH IMMIGRANTS REACHED BOULDER IN THE 1870'S, TRAVELING TO THE CITY FOR WORK. PETER MAGNUS SHOLD, WHO CAME TO BOULDER IN 1882, ENCOURAGED ESTABLISHMENT OF A LUTHERAN CHURCH IN BOULDER. A SMALL CONGREGATION BEGAN MEETING IN SCOTT'S BOULDER TENTH STREET IN 1892, WHEN THEY OFFICIALLY INCORPORATED AS THE SWEDISH EVANGELICAL BETHESDA LUTHERAN CHURCH, AND COMPLETED THE CHURCH AT 11TH AND MAPLETON IN 1895. THE CATHOLIC REVIVALISTS BUILDING FEATURES POINTED-ARCH WINDOWS, A STEEP GABLE ROOF, AND A ROUND WINDOW IN THE FINAL REAR ARCHITECTURAL PROJECTING ENTRY VESTIBULE. IT IS CONSTRUCTED OF BRICK WITH SANDSTONE TICH, BOUTICATED SANDSTONE FOUNDATIONS, AND BUTTRESSES CAPPED WITH SANDSTONE.
